- 5. ARTISTIC** - a cowboy/rancher who was also a poet, artist, musician, writer, and/or craftsman.
- 6. FAMILY** - members have been involved in cowboy activities for three or more generations.
- 7. CENTURY RANCHES** - ranches that have been in the *same family* for 100 years or more.
- 8. BUILDER of WESTERN CULTURE** – a person supportive and/or beneficial in the building of western culture.
